U.P. State Medical Faculty is inviting applications from qualified candidates for the post of Consultant (to assist in Nursing course(s)/ college(s) related reformative and upgradation activities) on purely contractual basis.

Roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Coordinating with external agencies (like QCI, INC etc.) and partners to ensure quality assessment of all nursing colleges.
- 2. Assisting readiness of all nursing colleges for quality assessments and ensuring appropriate dissemination of information for the same
- 3. Evaluating the data and preparing reports/presentations on quality assessments of nursing colleges as required and asked by competent or reporting authority.
- 4. Maintaining and re-evaluating quality assurance tool for nursing colleges from time to time
- 5. Supporting and assisting efforts of the organisation to identify centres for skill enhancement of nursing colleges to conduct nursing faculty development programs.
- 6. Building institutional capacity of identified centres for skill enhancement (CSE) with support from health partners and other agencies.
- 7. Establishing systems to monitor and ensure quality of faculty development programs being conducted at the CSE's
